- The meeting participants express concern about the amount of garbage and dumping in their community.
- They discussed the need to change the mindset and culture of the people in the community to address this issue
- Suggestions are made to hold meetings with agencies and elected officials to address the problem.
- The participants also mention specific locations where garbage is a problem, such as a Dollar General store and a truck on 2nd Street.
- Michael Hill plans to reach out to elected officials and provide an update on their response in the next meeting.
- Michael Hill requests Jat to send an email with a follow-up request to the sanitation email address. Action items
- Organize a demonstration or media event to bring attention to the sanitation issues in the community.
- Take a picture of the flat screen TV with the big back sitting outside for two years and post it on Twitter or Instagram

- Reach out to the mayor's office to inquire about the legality of posting pictures on social media regarding sanitation issues
- Write a letter to the sanitation commissioner documenting complaints and lack of action from local sanitation boards
- Reach out to Miss Brazer to inquire about district manager cabinet meetings and if they are still being held
- Monitor the Dollar General on Farragut Road for improvements in their garbage preparation and report any issues to Vanessa Quashie
- Contact the elected officials mentioned in the meeting to discuss the sanitation issues and possible solutions
