Presentations:

Floyd Jarvis: Director of Cannabis Workforce and Business Development Center:

- We are a part of a 2-million-dollar grant in partnership with Lehman College, who will handle the small business development of cannabis company we will handle the workforce development.
- First part of our program is training cannabis security professionals with 8- and 16-hour training, and it is a 2-month training.
- The 2nd part of it is a job readiness component where we asked cannabis professionals and cannabis dispensary owners what they need.
- The 3rd part is Cannabis manufacturing technician, which trains persons on how to work in cannabis Labs with cannabis tinctures cannabis the various cannabis extraction processes.
- With the micro business, you must cultivate and do something else must such as retail or dispensary. There could be about 3500 square feet.

Detective Skinner 67th Precinct:

- Let you guys know so far for the crime stats so far in a year, we're down 7% in overall crime.
- We're down 6% in homicides. We're down 22% robberies. We're down 14% burglaries, down 6% grand larcenies and we're down 13% stolen vehicles.

- Unfortunately, like, we saw an increase in rapes, 33 this year as opposed to 26, but what we've been seeing is that it has been mostly domestic, and we also saw increase in felonies assaults.
- We have 160-gun arrests year to date with 125 guns recovered.
- 346 vehicles have been towed.
- Also just be aware, it is the holiday time and there has been a lot of scams. A lot around banking, my advice is to hang up or the go into the bank the next day or call yourself.
