HOUSING MEETING UPDATE:

The most recent meeting of the Housing/Block Association Committee was held on March 5, 2025. Our guest speakers at this meeting, Ms. Allyson Martinez and Ms. Joan Erskine from Brooklyn Level Up. They presented information on the Tax Lien sale, responded to questions and requested our community support. There are currently 1100 properties in CB-17 that are currently on the Tax Lien list. Brookly Level Up is currently working to reduce this list so that generational wealth will remain in communities of color. Legislature braces for N.Y. housing voucher budget fight By Kate Lisa New York State PUBLISHED 7:55 PM ET Feb. 04, 2025

New York lawmakers Tuesday said the state budget must fund housing vouchers that Gov. Kathy Hochul's executive proposal didn't include to help low-income families avoid homelessness.

Lawmakers have started the earliest stages of budget talks, but said they plan to pressure the governor to fund other housing programs, including the Housing Access Voucher Program, to help 20,000 low-income households avoid foreclosure or eviction.

WIN NYC

WIN NYC (https://winnyc.org/) is a nonprofit that provides housing for formerly homeless people and family shelters. Win clients can receive housing vouchers through programs like the Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) program, also known as Section 8.

How does the HCV program work?

- The program provides a rental subsidy to eligible low- and moderate-income families
- Families receive a voucher to help them find housing
- Families pay a portion of their rent, and NYCHA pays the rest to the landlord
- Families must meet certain requirements, such as completing annual certifications and allowing property owners to make repairs
