Public Safety Committee meeting,

Agenda: Liquor License application

Applicant: Club **2020 LLC, 225 47th street**

Upon opening the discussion, the history of this location was noted by the attorney on behalf of the Proprietor, Sonia who owns a bakery in Coney Island for the past 15 years, started off as just a bakery and has grown to the point where they need a new location to conduct business. they want to be a good neighbor and are **willing to commit to paper regarding the hours of operations.*****

proposed hours of operations: 10pm-4am Thursday-Sunday (Nightlife),

Catered events will vary depending on the event -

a floor plan was shared indicating two spaces , one space(Area b)400 (cap) is slated to be used for catering birthdays, baptisms, weddings etc..the other side(area A)(200 cap) w/ chairs and tables, is to be used for "Nightlife functions" Mr James (attorney) made mention that the nightlife would not be on the level as the previous establishment ie.. strip club, hip hop , acts that sell out the Barkley, the plan is to play Latin music to 25 and above patrons. It was also stated that the two sides (one catering the other nightlife) would not function on the same evening **they would commit to writing** there is their proposed "method of operation as per Mr James.

there was concern voiced by the community members (RV) present as to the extent of the proprietors experience dealing with Nightlife as well as the type of nightlife expected, the response was that she has nightlife experience in her county , Was asked (RV) whether or not there was a relationship with the previous owner ? the answer was no.*****Mr James Stated that they would submit such in writing..**

A question was raised (JB) regarding the music that may be playing until 4am on a weekday (Thursday into Friday) and its impact on those that must go to work and school, Mr James said that they are doing extensive sound proofing so that the loud music does not emanate from the location.

a question arose regarding food being served soup, salad , cold sandwiches,(legal minimum food) are what would be served,as required, this was the response by Mr James as the dialog continued , the proprietor made a statement contrary to, she stated that **NO** food would be served in the Night club area....

SECURITY, 2 guards in the street at all times, shared ride pick up points, reflective vests so they can be easily spotted , 2 SG ID & wandng etc...a male and female pair searching the patrons prior to entry

total staff 15 at the location

the committee did not vote as Club 2020 was asked to bring, in writing the commitments stated to date there has been NO documents submitted
