FDNY Community Programs

The FDNY Community Affairs Unit has assembled teams of members to tackle ongoing public safety issues. Dispatched daily across the five boroughs, FDNY's educators have become a critical component of the Department's mission to keep the Big Apple safe.

Fire Safety Education Program

Seeks to eliminate fire deaths.

Youth Firesetters Intervention Program

Educates and evaluates children (up to the age of 12) who are engaging in fire play.

Free CPR Program

Offers New Yorkers a free, 30-minute class on hands-only CPR.

Teens Take Heart CPR Program

Customized, hands-only CPR training aimed at high school students

Get Alarmed NYC

Free smoke alarms to New York City residents.
